Curriculum News

In Math, we have been working on adding and subtracting whole numbers using the standard algorithm, using rounding to estimate, and place value of whole numbers. We also conducted a fantasy football draft to help us with our adding and estimating! We have also been starting to work on the relationship of tenths and hundredths in fractions and decimal concepts, and will be starting addition and subtraction of decimals and fractions soon.

In Language Arts, we have finished reading Red Kayak by Priscilla Cummings as a whole class and have been starting to launch our first Reader's Workshop unit on Characterization. Students have learned how to find a just right book, and are learning new skills and strategies to become a better reader. Students are also learning the components of narrative writing as we continue integrating the Writer's Workshop approach in class.

In Science, students are talking about the sun, moon, and stars with Miss Downing.

Me, Oh! Maya! In Social Studies, we are going to be travelling back in time as we get started with our unit on ancient civilizations while we study the Mayas, Incas, and Aztecs.
