

Country Report Tri-Fold Presentation Board

(approximate size of board = 48" x 36")

You must include the following information on your tri-fold presentation board. Remember, this is the minimum of what you should include. You may (and should) include any additional information that you would like.

- Name of the country (this should be in the center portion of the board)
- Physical map of the country (does not need to be hand-drawn)
- Political map of the country (does not need to be hand-drawn)
- Flag of the country (does not need to be hand-drawn)
- Recipe of a dish that you have made
- List of "Quick Facts" about country (*at least 10*)
- Any pictures that you would like **with captions** explaining them. All captions must be written as complete sentences.
- Your name should be written in the bottom right-hand corner on the front of the poster board.
- Any additional information you choose to include.

You will be graded on your presentation of accurate information.

Remember that spelling, neatness, and creativity count!

Country Fair Presentation Board Rubric – February 14, 2018

This is the scale used when evaluating:

- 4**—This is the student's absolute best work, shows the student challenged himself/herself, followed directions, did more than was needed and no adjustments are necessary.
- 3**—Very good work, shows strong effort, instructions followed, and minor adjustments could have made it better.
- 2**—The student completed the work but did not put in full or extra effort into it, mostly followed the instructions, and there were several adjustments could have made to improve the work
- 1**—Student did the bare minimum of work required, put very little effort into the work, did not always follow instructions, and major adjustments needed to be made to improve the work
- 0**—Work was poor and shows very little effort, none of requirements met.

Presentation Requirements	Points
