

Riding Bicycles to School

Students in grades 4-6 may take bicycles onto school grounds if they have written permission from their parents.

The bicycle privilege may be denied by a principal for good cause.

Only those students designated as walkers will be allowed to ride their bikes.

Bicycles may not be ridden on school grounds.

The school is not responsible for the safety or care of bicycles.

Bicycle Safety Rules and Guidelines

1. Wear an official bicycle helmet as required by Massachusetts General Law.
2. Keep both hands on the handle bars except when doing turn signals.
3. Slow down and check traffic at all corners.
4. Walk your bike across busy streets.
5. Don't ride double.
6. Don't do stunts.
7. Never go in and out of traffic.
