WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME FROM SCHOOL

- \otimes If your child has a fever of 100° F or above.
- \otimes If your child is vomiting or has diarrhea.
- ⊗ If your child's eye is pink or red, itchy, and/or a crusty drainage from the eye is present.
- \otimes If your child has head lice or nits.



WHEN TO SEND YOUR CHILD BACK TO SCHOOL AFTER AN ILLNESS

- ✓ Fever-free for 24 hours.
- ✓ 24 hours after the start of antibiotic therapy for a bacterial infection.
- ✓ 24 hours without vomiting or diarrhea.
- ✓ 24 hours after treatment for bacterial conjunctivitis (pink-eye).
- ✓ After treatment for head lice, student must be assessed by the school nurse to comply with the school's nit-free policy.
