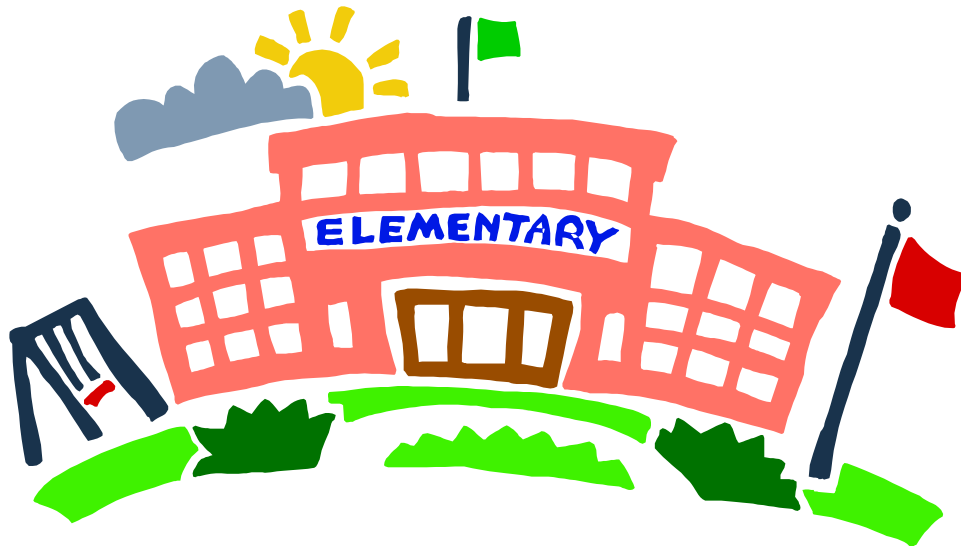


# After School Enrichment Program

## Tuesday

### Build It!

### Open Computer Lab (Roderick)

The after school open lab allows students to use all grade level software programs that are loaded on the computers, print classroom projects, and visit selected sites on the Internet. It is a free choice class. Structured lessons are not given. Students may explore: Scratch - A great program to learn how to code. Green Screen: Use the app DoInk to create fun pictures, Pro-Bots: Coding, Seesaw: An online program for students to create videos and write stories.
