It’s back! Be a part of this great Wrentham tradition! The re-birth of The Wrentham Pickleball Program for boys and girls. The program continues October 31st 2017. It is open to all girls and boys in the Town of Wrentham in grades 5 and 6. The program will take place on Tuesday afternoon from 3:00-4:30. Pickleball is a cross between tennis, ping-pong and badminton. It is a great activity to improve hand-eye coordination, agility, footwork and overall coordination. This will be a competitive league with games every week focused on fundamental Pickleball skills. Please find the link below to check out the rules of the game!

THE PICKLEBALL PROGRAM

There is a \$75.00 fee per session for all children participating in the program. The fee must be paid prior to your child’s participation in one of the sessions. Please make checks payable to the Wrentham Public Schools.

- 1) This program is limited to 22 students for each session. Sign-ups will be on a first-come/first-serve basis. Registration for session 1 is due by October 30th
- 2) **This is the 1st session** of the school year. **October 31st-December 19th (8 weeks**, and includes student tournaments).
- 3) Students will play competitive games against different teams and opponents each week. Each team will consist of 2 players. After the regular season games there will be a doubles and singles tournament (last 2 weeks), which is included in the cost of the program. Most regular season games will be doubles format. (4 people to a court).

The final tournament of the school year will be the traditional Staff/Student Doubles tournament. This will take place at the end of session 3 in June. Any student who participated in any session throughout the year may play. Students must find a current staff member of Wrentham Public Schools to be his/her partner. This tournament will be *single* elimination.

All games will be held in the Gibbons Gymnasium.
